



The Rodney Green Organ Scholarship 2016

Rodney Green has provided funds for an Organ scholarship for a student studying the MA or MMus performance, based at St Andrews United Reform Church, Roundhay, Leeds <http://www.standrews.cc/>

The successful applicant will benefit from:

- A £3,000 tuition fee waiver
- Reasonable access to St Andrews' newly refurbished 3 manual Abbott and Smith organ.
- The opportunity to promote recitals
- The opportunity to become a member of a lively and enterprising church community.

In return, the scholarship holder will be required to fulfil the following duties:

- Play at 15 Sunday services in the year, selecting appropriate music in consultation with the minister or other worship leader;
- Contribute to other musical activities in the church;
- Present no fewer than two recitals each year (including the assessment recital)
- Work with the existing music team to contribute to the church's musical activity
- Contribute to the church's youth and community programme.

In addition the scholarship holder will be required to agree to the following conditions:

- To take part in meetings or events for Scholarship holders at Leeds College of Music
- To include reference to the award in their CV/biography
- To support the Conservatoire's fundraising and marketing activities where appropriate e.g. to take part /play at special events if requested, or feature in articles, videos etc.

Application process
