Introduction

If you apply for the **Foundation Degree Music Production** or the **Foundation Degree Electronic Music Production** course you may receive an offer based on your UCAS application alone. If we are unable to make a decision based on your application we may ask you to submit further evidence in support of your application in the form of a portfolio of work and / or via an interview (in person or over the phone).

PORTFOLIO SUBMISSION GUIDE (IF REQUESTED)

Foundation Degree in Music Production

If we are unable to make a decision based on your UCAS application you may be invited to submit a portfolio for assessment as follows.

1. **A portfolio of no longer than 6 minutes that includes a variety of material, including at least one of your own original compositions.**
 - You may use coursework that you have prepared for BTEC / AS Level or any other material.
2. **A short written document or video to answer the following questions:**
 - Why do you want to study at Leeds Conservatoire?
 - What are you hoping to gain from doing the course?
 - Who are your influences as a producer/composer/performer and why?
 - What do you want to do once you've finished your studies?

- The written document must be submitted as either a .pdf or a .doc (Word) file. If you prefer to submit a video answering these questions.
- Submitting your materials: Instructions on how to send your files will be included in your formal invitation to submit them.

Entry Requirements

- 64 UCAS tariff points from level 3 studies or equivalent which normally include A Level Music or a BTEC Extended Diploma in a Music-related subject.
- A minimum of three GCSEs including English Language at Grade C / Grade 4 or above or equivalent international qualification, eg IELTS 6.0 (5.5 in each component).

The Foundation Degrees are not suitable for applicants who would require a Student Visa to study in the UK.
